

INDIA - Cherries**Current as of: 05/20/2013**

From Areas under quarantine for *Ceratitis capitata*, and/or Areas where *Rhagoletis* spp. (cherry fruit flies) are known to occur.

Phytosanitary Certificate (PC) and Import Permit (IP) are required.

32 g / 1 m ³	21 + C	2 Hours	Must be done under NAP

Additional Information:

- An Import Permit is recommended. Some import permits state MB fumigation at NAP or equivalent which allows for a different concentration/temperature from PEXD.
- Additional Declaration must be written as listed on Import Permit (IP).
- Must be fumigated or have a pre-shipment cold treatment
- Must include net weight in kilograms in block 9
