Phytosanitary certificate (PC) and Import Permit (IP) are required.

Inspection Note:

- Commodity summary use Malus sp. Fruit.
- Import permit states the AD and lists the Special Conditions required.
- **Read the import permit and select the correct AD.**
- Fruit from *Rhagoletis pomonella* (apple maggot) quarantine areas must be cold treated, see import permit for required cold treatments.
- Net weight of commodity in metric tons (MT) or kilograms (kg) must be included on Block 9 of the Phytosanitary certificate.
- The AD on the Import Permit must be stated on the Phytosanitary certificate as written on the Import Permit.
