To use this AD the fruit must come from an area free of Rhagoletis pomonella (apple maggot).

The fruit is free from *Cydia pomonella* (codling moth), *Epiphyas postvittana* (light brown apple moth), *Erwinia amylovora* (fire blight), *Pseudococcus calceolariae* (scarlet mealy bug), and *Pseudococcus comstocki* (Comstock mealy bug). The fruit was produced in an area free from *Rhagoletis pomonella* (apple maggot). *Ceratitis capitata* (Mediterranean fruit fly) does not occur in the United States. Import permit number _____ was presented.

To use this AD the fruit comes from an area regulated for Rhagoletis pomonella (apple maggot) and will have a cold treatment.

The fruit is free from *Cydia pomonella* (codling moth), *Epiphyas postvittana* (light brown apple moth), *Erwinia amylovora* (fire blight), *Pseudococcus calceolariae* (scarlet mealy bug), and *Pseudococcus comstocki* (Comstock mealy bug) and *Rhagoletis pomonella* (apple maggot). *Ceratitis capitata* (Mediterranean fruit fly) does not occur in the United States. Import permit number _____ was presented.

OR

To use this AD the fruit can come from a regulated or non regulated area for Rhagoletis pomonella (apple maggot) and may have a cold treatment.

The fruit is free from *Cydia pomonella* (codling moth), *Epiphyas postvittana* (light brown apple moth), *Erwinia amylovora* (fireblight), *Pseudococcus calceolariae* (scarlet mealy bug), *Pseudococcus comstocki* (Comstock mealy bug), *Rhagoletis pomonella* (apple maggot), *Anthonomus quadrigibbus* (apple curculio), *Epidiaspis leperii* (European pear scale) and *Grapholita molesta* (Oriental fruit fly).

Anastrepha fraterculus (South American fruit fly), *Anastrepha ludens* (Mexican fruit fly), *Anastrepha serpentina* (Sapodilla fruit fly), *Anastrepha suspensa* (Caribbean fruit fly) and *Ceratitis capitata* (Mediterranean fruit fly), do not occur in the United States. Import permit number _____ was presented.

- Fruit from *Rhagoletis pomonella* (apple maggot) quarantine areas must be cold treated, see import permit for required cold treatments.
