

Phytosanitary Certificate (PC) is required.

Additional Declaration is required. See PExD for current AD.

The apple in this consignment have been inspected in accordance with appropriate official procedures and found to be free of any visually detectable quarantine pests as specified by the New Zealand Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry. The apples in this consignment have been treated in accordance with Appendix 1(d) of the work plan between the New Zealand Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry and the United States of America national plant protection organization concerning the access of host material of fruit fly of economic significance into New Zealand from the United States of America. The apples in this consignment have been sourced from an area free (verified by an official detection survey) from *Conotrachelus nenuphar*. The apples in this consignment have undergone appropriate pest control activities that are effective against *Gymnosporangium clavipes*, and *Operophtera brumata*.
