Additional Information

- Please refer to the Transiting Requirements attachment in the General Information Section under Supporting Documents for additional guidance.
- All fruit transiting a third country or through a fruit fly regulated area (California) must meet Taiwan's transiting requirements.
- Shipments that originate in States other than California, but will be shipped from California should be safeguarded when passing through the regulated areas and be in pest-proof packaging with a coded seal number recorded on the phytosanitary certificate.
- Transiting California and shipped in sealed packages, the shipment is allowed to pass through fruit fly regulated area with the proper Additional Declaration (AD) found in PExD.
- Transiting California and shipped in non-sealed packages, the shipment is not allowed to pass through fruit fly regulated area. The proper AD as found in PExD is required.
