- The county of origin, name and location (city and state) of the packing house must be listed on the PC.
- Each carton will have the name and location of the packing house, the grower lot number and the date of pack.

For certification, with respect to *Erwinia amylovora*:

1. As this pest is a bacterium, we cannot certify there are no bacteria present on this (or any commodity). Our certification is that no symptoms are observed on the fruit and that Item 2, below, has been met. Therefore, the disease causing organism should not be present.
2. Commercially produced, sorted, graded, packed, and shipped apples that have passed official inspection may be considered to be free of *Erwinia amylovora* and certified as required by Taiwan.
