Additional Information

- Certify potatoes from the U.S. for export to Taiwan under an area freedom concept where the "area" in question means "the area or field from which the potatoes were harvested."
- Only potatoes that have come from inspected, blight free fields are eligible for certification.
- The potatoes will be given a normal phytosanitary inspection by an authorized State or Federal officer to ensure no pests or diseases of concern to Taiwan are present.
- Any suspect tubers will be tested to confirm the A2 late blight disease free status.
- An additional declaration will be required for zebra chip disease on potato shipments from the US
