- Arrival:** You are requested to report on **Monday, December 5, 2011**, to the SCORE Jail , 20817 17th Ave S, Des Moines, WA. **Classroom hours are 0800-1700.**
- Travel/Meals & Lodging:** Is the responsibility of the applicant or his/her agency.
- Costs/ Payment:** **\$75;**
Please note: WSCJTC is unable to accept credit cards as a form of payment.
- Attire:** **Business casual** attire is appropriate for classroom wear. *Please no jeans, t-shirts, shorts, sweatshirts, or tennis shoes.*
- Note-Taking:** Note-taking items such as notebook paper, pens, and pencils, will **not** be made available at the training site, and are the responsibility of each attendee.
- Smoking/ Alcohol:** Alcohol and controlled substances are not permitted anywhere within Commission dormitories or on Commission premises. Smoking is prohibited in Commission housing.
