Overview:

Classroom education and presentation on the information, considerations, and tactics the police supervisor needs for successfully managing critical incidents. The supervisor's role in managing the risks to public safety, employees, and the liabilities of organizational resources entrusted to them will be explored and fully appreciated in this course of instruction. Certificate of training issued upon completion of course.

- Applying the 4 C's of response
- First responder REACT Team
- Use of force options and tactics
- Critical Incident types, scope, & tactics

- Incident transition to Tactical Team
- Initial supervisor's role in officer involved shooting
