



AMBER/EMPA portal upgrade training (LEAP)

The Washington State Patrol will be presenting training on the updated AMBER and Endangered Missing Persons Advisory web portal; the LEAP system. The web portal will be undergoing an upgrade and there will be some changes to process within the portal.

During this training we will also discuss differences between AMBER and EMPA and the differences in alerting methods for each. We will also discuss and clarify criteria.

Audience: Law enforcement officers and detectives, dispatchers, and records personnel that will be doing actual entries, updates, and cancellations of AMBER alerts and/or Endangered Missing Persons Alerts.
