The Issaquah Police Department is a progressive, professional agency which operates a municipal jail. Gender-specific (female) hiring preference may apply to fill the Corrections Officer positions in order to create a safer booking process of same gender pat-downs, for minimum staffing levels and to comply with conventional standards of sexual privacy." Corrections officers work in a team setting, receive ongoing training, and perform daily functions for the safety of all inmates and staff. The work schedule consists of four 12 hour shifts, two day shifts and two night shifts (6 am – 6p.m.; 6p.m. – 6a.m.), followed by four days off. Those meet the minimum requirements may be invited to participate in the testing process. Qualified applicants will be notified of the exact time and location for oral board interviews. The successful candidates must then pass the medical and physical examinations, including a drug screen, polygraph test, psychological examination, and extensive background check.
