The City of Prosser Civil Service Commission is now accepting applications for the position of LATERAL/EXCEPTIONAL ENTRY POLICE OFFICER. This position is union and is classified as Fair Labor Standards Act non-exempt.

Minimum Requirements:

1. You must have completed the testing process and been hired by another agency/department within the State of Washington, from a Civil Service Commission certified eligibility list of like process.
2. You must have successfully completed your probationary period with your current or previous law enforcement employer.
3. You must have been continuously employed by your present or previous employer as civilian law enforcement for not less than 12 months in Washington State. You must have been employed as a law enforcement within the last 24 months.
4. You must have graduated from the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Academy for law enforcement. If you have not, you must be able to challenge the process for an equivalency certification.
