Reserve Patrol Officer

The Post Falls Police Department is accepting applications for the position of Reserve Patrol Officer. Successful applicants will be required to pass an oral interview, polygraph examination, and POST physical fitness test.

The Post Falls Reserve Patrol program is a volunteer program. Performs general police work and investigative police work in the protection of life and property through enforcement of laws and ordinances: working with full time staff, volunteers respond to calls as assigned; makes arrests and may be assigned in specialized areas such as community services, criminal investigations, administration, field training and performs related work as required.

Minimum Qualifications: Must be at least 21 YOA, have a valid driver's license and two years of related work experience.

Spokane Street or on the City's website at www.postfallsidaho.org. Applications must be returned by 4:00 p.m. on August 3rd.
