



**The IDAHO ICAC and WASHINGTON ICAC will be hosting ICAC-P2P  
August 30<sup>th</sup> thru September 1, 2011 in Spokane, Washington.**

**Course Description:** Designed to provide instruction on how to conduct investigations on peer-to-peer file sharing networks using software tools.

This 2 1/2 day training program is to provide experienced investigators with the training, materials and tools necessary to investigate the use of peer-to-peer file sharing networks using advanced technology developed as a result of previous peer-to-peer investigations. Students will receive training on the RoundUp tool, an open source Gnutella investigation program. RoundUp was developed collaboratively between Georgetown University, U-MASS Amherst, Massachusetts State Police and Pennsylvania State Police. This is yet another tool which can be added to the ICAC Task Force Program's arsenal of peer-to-peer file sharing investigative tools.

**The class is FREE and open to only 20 ICAC team members; you must be approved by an ICAC Commander.**
