



# Southwest Regional EVOC

The Vancouver Police Department and the Clark County Sheriff's Office will be hosting the annual Southwest Regional Emergency Vehicle Operation Course (EVOC) beginning October 14, 2009. The dates for the training are: October 14, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 25, 26, 27, 28, 31 and November 1, 2, 3, 4, 2011. This year's course will be 3-hours in length and will include classroom, placement course, autocross course, speed skill course (track), and PIT qualification.

The fee for this year's training is **\$100** per officer scheduled. Please be advised that agencies will be billed for all slots that are reserved regardless of whether the scheduled officer attends or not. Cancellations need to be made 48-hours in advance of the scheduled session or your agency will be billed. If you need to cancel or reschedule an officer, please e-mail Carie Wright at the e-mail address below. If an officer is unavailable to attend his/her assigned session, another officer can be substituted without notifying VPD.

It has been suggested that you check with your Risk Management or Cities Insurance Company as they might reimburse you for all or a portion of this training cost. It is considered preventative training.

PIT Basic will be offered on **October 26, 2011** from 1300-1700. The cost for PIT Basic will be **\$100.00**. Vehicles will be provided for this training.

**NOTE:** Any track repair costs relating to damage caused by an officer will be the responsibility of the officer's agency.

You can click on the "Emergency Vehicle Operators Course (EVOC)" link on the page. Then you can click at the top of the calendar to maneuver from month to month. Click on the calendar day desired to see what slots are available. You can download the registration form from any EVOC calendar day screen.

Determine which of the available day and time slots you would like to have your personnel attend. If you have any questions, please call me at (360) 487-7555. Every attempt will be made to schedule your selections; however, slots will be booked on a first come first serve basis. There may be times when a slot selected has been filled but the internet site has not been updated. Every effort will be made to keep the internet site updated on a regular basis.

Please make every attempt to have your officers at Portland International Raceway (PIR) prior to the starting time of their training. Directions to PIR are on VPD's Training website.

**PREREQUISITE:** Attendees must have completed basic EVOC to attend this training.

Please make sure you carefully read and follow the important vehicle guidelines regarding vehicles that are being sent to EVOC training.
