Faces & Shots In the Dark: The Serial Shooter Investigation and Trial

Between May, 2005, and July, 2006, Phoenix metropolitan area residents were the targets of an unprecedented series of violent attacks on their lives and the lives of their pets and farm animals. Using a shotgun and a .22 rifle, unidentified individual(s) were stalking innocent victims to commit cold-blooded murder and attempted murder. Numerous dogs and horses were also killed or seriously injured. As the terrorizing continued, the unknown culprit responsible for the mayhem was dubbed "The Serial Shooter". On August 2, 2006, Dale Hausner and Samuel Dieteman were arrested after an Emergency Wiretap was implemented and resulted in the two men making incriminating statements. Laura and her co-counsel began the trial for Dale Hausner on September 3, 2008, which involved 87 separate crimes involving, First Degree Murder, Attempted Murder, Drive By Shooting, Arson and Animal Cruelty (just to name a few). The case came to its final conclusion seven months later on March 30, 2009, after the admission of over 1,000 exhibits and over 150 witnesses testified. After his convictions, Dale Hausner received six death sentences, one life sentence and over 300 years in prison. This seminar walks through the investigation, the challenges law enforcement faced and the issues faced at trial.
