COURSE INFORMATION:

Upon completion of this 2 hour training program, participants will be familiar with the Law Enforcement Tactical Board and/or similar products. The LE Tactical Board is a Command, Accountability and Tactical Objectives tracking system used by LE and other Multi-Agency Command Systems to track team members, resources and assets during any critical event such as (*but not limited to*) a Natural Disaster, Active Shooter, Barricaded Subject, Bank Robbery, Hostage Situation, SWAT Call-out or a Missing Person.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Law Enforcement First Responders, First Level Supervisors and Command Officials.

COURSE TOPICS INCLUDE:

This is a 'hands-on' interactive course that will incorporate a tabletop exercise based upon an initial law enforcement response scenario. We will not actually leave the training site. Basic familiarity with the NIMS Incident Command System is a plus but not a prerequisite.

This is not a sales pitch for any particular product, but rather a course of instruction to reinforce the ICS concept by demonstrating its clear value and ease of implementation, even from the back of a patrol car.
