Basic Mountain Operations Course 2012

The Law Enforcement Mountain Operations School will be offering two sessions of the Basic Mountain Operations Course (BMO) in 2012:

BMO 2012-01, January 7—12, 2012

BMO 2012-02, February 11—16, 2012

The cost for this course is \$125.00 (US) per student and includes food, housing and course materials.

Both courses will be conducted at the Priest Lake Ranger Station, Priest Lake, Idaho. As a participating member of the Okanogan IBET and or an allied agency, your department is eligible to participate. Sponsoring Okanogan IBET agencies have enrollment priority. Because of the high demand for this course, the enrollment deadline for these courses is **November 30, 2012.** Each course will be limited to a maximum size of 26 students.

The attached application form needs to be completed for each student being enrolled. This is a simultaneous application process for both courses and the student needs to indicate which course he or she is enrolling in. It is preferred that all of your agency's applications be sent in at one time, accompanied by a check for the total tuition payment. We can handle the applications individually if necessary or if they need to be sent in from different stations or offices. **We must receive the completed forms no later than the November 30, 2012 deadline.**

Students should be in good physical condition and capable of traveling 5 kilometers on snowshoes, carrying 30 pounds of equipment.
