Course Information: This course is divided into four major components;

- 1) **Size, Weight and Load & Load Securement:** The student will receive refresher training in how to properly weigh a commercial motor vehicle using portable scales to determine its compliance with city, county and state weight regulations and road restrictions. The student will receive working knowledge of the requirements for transporting over-dimensional and over legal weight loads. The student will receive refresher training in the federal and state regulations in governing the methods of load securement for commercial vehicles.
- 2) **Causes of Irregular Tire Wear and Drive Axle: Dual Wheels versus Super Singles:** This course will present an in-depth analysis of irregular tire wear and its causes and how they relate to other mechanical defects. It will also provide an in-depth analysis and the advantages of the new Super Singles. Information is provided by Michelin Tire.
- 3) **Heavy Equipment Dimensional / Weight Familiarization and Theft Recovery Training:** This course will provide to the student the tools to easily identify the weight and dimensional attributes of today's heavy equipment. It will also familiarize the student with the "PIN" (Part Identification Number) locations on most of today's heavy equipment. This acquired knowledge is meant to assist the inspector in the recovery of stolen heavy equipment.
- 4) **Bendix Disc Brake and ABS Braking Systems:** Automatic Braking Systems are common place on the average motor vehicle. ABS systems are now being seen more often in today's commercial motor vehicle. To properly inspect these systems the inspector must become familiar with its components and their functions.
