Course Description:

The PPCT Defensive Tactics System is the first subject control system developed through tactics, legal and medical research. Tactically, the system addresses the most common types of resistance officer's encounter, allowing the instructor to maximize training on job-related techniques. Legally, the system teaches a simple use of force continuum that clarifies the appropriate force level for every level of resistance.

The course will be taught by Detective Robert Benson, a PPCT Instructor since 2000 and an Instructor Trainer in Defensive Tactics since 2005.

Prerequisite: No prerequisites are necessary for the Instructor course. For the Re-Cert course, attendees must be a current PPCT DT Instructor.

PPCT Combat Firearms Instructor School

Date: August 22-24, 2012

Cost \$300

Course Description:

This course is designed to provide law enforcement officers with the skill, knowledge, and abilities to enhance officer survival during combat situations. Currently, officers are trained to the standard where they have time, distance, and cover. This course will focus on the tactical environment whereas the officer experiences a startle response. The information is based upon an extensive amount of research, leading to the methodology used to design this course with the intention of developing the ability to predict behaviors, both cognitively and unconsciously in order to form a pattern of threat recognition.

WSP Auto Theft Training/WSP Crime Lab Vehicle Processing

Course Description:

Richland Police Department is hosting a three-day auto theft / vehicle processing class. This class is aimed at the patrol officer/deputy. The first day will be classroom instruction taught by WSP Sgt. Dave Bolton and Trooper Jeff Thoet. Topics will introduce the patrol officer/deputy to proper theft and recovery reporting, auto theft laws, basic VIN locations & fraudulent VIN identification, basic chop shop identification, auto theft investigation, etc. The 2nd & 3rd day will be taught by WSP Crime Lab in how to properly process a recovered stolen vehicle. Several evidence collection techniques will be discussed and demonstrated. Vehicles will be provided to the class for practical application & instruction.
