**Hidden Compartment Detection Course**

Students will obtain a usable knowledge of different techniques to safely locate and open electronic compartments without injury or permanent damage to the vehicle. The student will leave this course with the basic knowledge associated with identifying signs associated with the potential presence of a hidden compartment, systematic searches, interviewing, liabilities, and current trafficking trends.
