Tactical Gunshot Wound Management

This course is being offered by the Anacortes Police Department, Anacortes Fire Department, the Skagit Criminal Justice Training Council and Skagit County Medic One. The instructors are TC III trained tactical medics and/or physicians and current or former tactical team operators. This course is built for patrol officers and tactical teams. The cost is \$50 per attendee, which includes a gunshot wound management kit issued to each, following the training. This is a one day course (8 hours) being offered three times this year.

Effective gunshot wound management begins with a dynamic and coordinated tactical response to a critical incident. 90% of combat casualties in the Middle East have been a result of extremity hemorrhaging. In this course, those in attendance will learn how to quickly establish tactical control of the situation as it unfolds and the effective treatment of gunshot wounds with minimal medical equipment.

The morning session will start with a two hour classroom presentation which will include: basic anatomy, types of bleeding, types of gunshot wounds, treatment options, use of tourniquets, use of nasopharyngeal airways, wound packing, types of equipment recommended and types not recommended, kit set-up and hands-on demonstrations.

The afternoon session will include hands-on practical exercises in simulated wound packing, application of nasopharyngeal airways, use of tourniquets, use of air support and the evacuation of casualties. During this session, dynamic scenario based training will take place, which includes the four stages of gunshot wound management, (address the threats, control bleeding, care under fire and CASEVAC). Downed officer rescue techniques will be learned, including trunk rescues as a team.

Each registered attendee will be sent an email with the required equipment to bring. Airsoft training weapons will be used during this training.
