DESCRIPTION:

Representatives from NICS, DOL and WSP will be traveling across the state, providing the two-day seminar. The NSST Liaison Specialist's will provide training on NICS topics and materials during the first day and again during the first half of the second day. Attendees will then receive training from DOL representatives during the final half of the second day. WSP Access staff will be in attendance during all training to provide additional guidance and support.

The NICS Liaison instruction will primarily cover the ten federal firearm prohibitions, Section 922 (g) or (n) of Title 18, United States Code. The ten prohibitions will be broken down into individual training modules followed by detailed exercises reinforcing the federal prohibition.

Each attendee will receive customized training materials consisting of a NSST's Quick Reference Guide 2012 and a Presentations and Exercises Booklet.

Additional education will be provided on topics specific to Washington and surrounding states regarding state firearm prohibitions, state terminology, state charges/domestic violence force criteria, and state specific pardons and restoration interpretation. The class will also include information on the history of the NICS, the NICS process, the Voluntary Appeals File, NICS status notifications, guidelines for accessing the NICS, and the NICS Index.
