Cruelty Investigators Academy

The Cruelty Investigators Academy (CIA) is designed to help you be the best investigator you can be. This course is intended for federal, state and local officers who must investigate animal crimes. Three levels, consisting of 40 hours each, will provide instruction in all aspects of animal cruelty investigations. Level I should be taken first, but can be followed by Levels II and III in either order.
