Course Descriptions

- ◆ **Today's Threat Picture**
Provides an overview of the general threat picture to law enforcement officers.
- ◆ **The Deadly Mix**
Provides an overview of 15 years of research dedicated to the interaction between the officer, the offender, and the circumstances that brought them together.
- ◆ **Pre-Incident Indicators of Violent Attacks**
Designed to increase law enforcement officers' awareness and understanding of the totality of circumstances and pre-incident indicators of violent attacks against law enforcement officers.
- ◆ **Characteristics of Armed Gunmen**
Examines some of the common characteristics of street-level criminal gunmen. This includes the behaviors, movements, and visual cues that may indicate the presence of a firearm.
- ◆ **The Professional**
Examines the concept of law enforcement as a profession, focusing on three key components—scholar, statesman, and warrior.
