

About The Class

This 8-hour course of instruction will give the student a basic working knowledge in understanding of "Suicide by Cop". The officer will learn about the phenomenon and the theory behind "Suicide by Cop". Having this knowledge could help recognize and in some cases stop individuals contemplating "Suicide by Cop". Dr. Drylie will talk about "Suicide by Cop" in social media sites. Dr. Drylie will also discuss building personal resiliency in the case where an officer is involved in a "Suicide by Cop" incident.

About the Speaker

Dr. James J. Drylie is the Executive Director of the School of Criminal Justice & Public Administration at Kean University of New Jersey. He has conducted exhaustive research on the subject of suicide-by-cop formulating the theory of victim-scripted suicide as an objective measure in examining these types of police-involved shootings and is regularly consulted on matters of this nature. Retired at the rank of captain, after twenty-five years of service with a large suburban New Jersey police department, he routinely lectures on the subject of suicide-by-cop and related issues to a variety of academic and practitioner audiences..

During the course of his law enforcement career Dr. Drylie was recognized as an expert in various aspects related to the use of force, specifically deadly force, and was responsible for training countless recruits and police officers throughout the New York/New Jersey Region. Dr Drylie has recently begun working with clinicians who study the impact of large scale disaster on first-responders and is researching the links between the psychological trauma from terrorist incidents, natural and man-made disaster, and human caused incidents such as police shootings.

Dr. Drylie received his Ph.D. in Criminal Justice from the City University of New York, John Jay College of Criminal Justice. He has published his dissertation work in *Suicide by Cop: Scripted Behavior Resulting in Police Deadly Force* (2007) as well as co-authoring a textbook, *Cop-I-Cide:*
