ABOUT THE CLASS

This 8-hour course of instruction will give the student a basic working knowledge of outlaw motorcycle gangs (OMGs) and their underlying sub-culture, with a specific emphasis on those OMGs that are active in the Pacific Northwest. Among the topics that will be covered are a basic history of OMGs, OMG culture and sociology, OMGs versus legitimate motorcycle clubs, Washington and Oregon OMGs and their support clubs, intelligence gathering, proper documentation in field reports, officer safety issues, Washington's new motorcycle profiling law, and OMG investigations (including working an OMG event and executing OMG search warrants).

ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Detective Joe Gagliardi has 13 years of law enforcement experience, eleven of which have been focused on the investigation of criminal street gangs. He began his career in California's Bay Area, where he worked as both a gang officer and a gang detective with the Fairfield Police Department. After relocating with his family to Washington State, he immediately began working street gangs for the King County Sheriff's Office, and is currently assigned as the Gang Intelligence Detective for the Gang Unit. He has also held previous assignments as a Field Training Officer, a SWAT officer, and a Defensive Tactics Instructor.

Joe has provided training on gang awareness and investigations for members of both law enforcement and the community, including training for local and National Gang Investigator's Conferences, the FBI National Academy, and law enforcement agencies throughout Washington State. He is the co-instructor for all Gang Awareness training at the Washington State CJTC Basic Law Enforcement Academies and Basic Corrections Officers Academies. He has testified as an expert on criminal street gangs on numerous occasions at both the state and federal levels, and has had personal contact with well over 1,350 individual criminal street gang members during his career.
