## NW3C Cyber-Investigation 105 – Basic Cell Phone Investigations (BCPI)

**DATE:** June 13-14th, 2013 0800-1700

**LOCATION:** Spokane Police Academy

**COST:** FREE

**DESCRIPTION:** NW3C presents this two day course that is designed as a basic introduction for officers, investigators and analysts needing the ability to initiate or follow up on cell phone related cases. It is based on proper techniques for seizing and preserving information found in cell phones and the acquisition and analysis of information external to the phone. The class will train investigators and analysts on how to request, read and analyze Call Detail Records provided by cellular providers, understand and plot cellular site locations used by suspect to determine the location of a suspect during a given time frame, and instruct first responders on how to seize and preserve evidence on a cell phone until that phone can be fully analyzed. No special hardware or software is required, just a new knowledge base to apply to cell phone cases. The student is then shown techniques for tying all this information together for case reports and/or for court room presentations.

The student is expected to have basic computer literacy with some experience in Microsoft Office.
