Deputy Chief Rod Covey, Port of Seattle PD, will cover key leadership concepts while walking the audience through "Ethical Autopsies." He will examine what lessons leadership should learn when an officer is disciplined or fired.

Covey has been involved in the discipline of over 1,000 officers during his career and believes that as many as 2/3^{ds} of those cases were a failure in leadership. He will show how good police officers fall from their path ultimately costing them their career. Many times while they were on that path, their friends or supervisors could have stopped them from continuing and falling to destruction.

Speaker Background



Rod Covey is a Deputy Chief for the Port of Seattle Police Department as well as a graduate of the 157th Session.

Covey assumed the position with POSPD in April 2009 after serving 32 years with the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS). Almost all of his time there was spent in leadership positions including assignments as the Commander of the Arizona Law Enforcement Training Academy, the Chief of Staff for the Director of Public Safety, the Chief of the Highway Patrol, the Chief of Operations, and the Assistant Director overseeing the Agency Support Division. He has served as the Executive Director of the Arizona Peace Officer Standards and Training Board (AZPOST) and the Director of the AZ Regional Community Policing Organization. He finished his time in Arizona as Director of the Center for Leadership Excellence at AZ POST.

Rod brings his extensive experience and expertise in leadership and organizational development to classrooms and organizations nationwide having trained and coached thousands of new and experienced leaders. He has worked with hundreds of federal, state, county, and city agencies to include the Washington State Patrol, the United States Capitol Police, and US Customs and Border Protection. Among the many courses he has developed and taught for over 30 years are lessons on performance management, leading change, coaching and mentoring, followership, transformational leadership, and the leader's role in creating and maintaining an ethical culture.

He is certified by the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) as a master instructor and faculty developer for the Leadership in Police Organization (LPO) Program. He is also a certified facilitator for FranklinCovey© with regard to the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People© and 7 Habits for Law Enforcement©.

Rod has an AA Degree in Criminal Justice from Central Arizona College, a Bachelor's Degree in Management from the University of Phoenix, and a Masters Degree from Northern Arizona University (NAU) in Educational Leadership. As a result of his work for NAU, he received membership into the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi. He is a graduate of the Arizona State University's Institute for Public Executives. In July 2012, he attended the 52nd Session of the Senior Management Institute for Policing (SMIP) at Boston University.
