- Jumpsuit, BDUs are acceptable but must have some type of shirt or jacket that identifies student as a Police Officer
- Boots with ankle support
- Eye Protection
- Ballistic Vest
- Gloves
- Outside agency participants must bring a letter authorizing billing of maintenance work performed by our (City of Tacoma) mechanics
