

## Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST) Refresher

### SFST Refresher

In conjunction with the Washington Traffic Safety Commission (WTSC) the Impaired Driving Section is offering a Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) Refresher Course. This course will be required for any and all law enforcement agency whose officers are awarded any additional grant funds through the Washington Traffic Safety Commission (WTSC). The SFST Refresher course is a three to four hour block of class room instruction. This course is also designed to include an optional “live” drinking lab workshop. This portion of the training is an additional four hours of hands on practical instruction (8 hours total).

The SFST Refresher course is an excellent means of staying current on DUI/SFST related issues. All interested law enforcement officers should have completed the SFST Basic Course prior to attending the “refresher” course.

**Scheduling the SFST Refresher will be done in conjunction with officers BAC recertification.** When officers receive their four hour BAC recertification training, they will have the option to register for the SFST Refresher course that will be conducted in the same location. All officers will receive letters of notification explaining the SFST Refresher Course at the same time they receive their BAC recertification letter.

Maximum class size of 20.
