From I-5: From I-5, take SR-500-East/Westfield Mall. Get in Right lane on SR-500. Follow SR-500 Westbound to light at Stapleton Rd. Turn Right onto Stapleton Rd. Follow to 2800 Stapleton Rd. Turn Right into West Precinct.
