Care under Fire- is a “hands on” course taught by Seattle PD tactical instructors, designed to teach Officers how to survive penetrating trauma. The methods instructed are proven in both law enforcement and battlefield environments.

It is especially applicable for patrol officers, as they will likely be injured in unsecured environments where Medics cannot, or will not enter. Officers now have the option of learning skills that may save their own lives, or the life of a partner. Take control of your own fate if you are shot or stabbed. Learn the skills of “Care under Fire.”
