# **FORCE OPTIONS**



**What:** Close-Quarter Pistol

**Details:**

The Spokane County Sheriff's Office has partnered with Jeff Hall and Force Options, LLC to host a Close-Quarter Pistol course. This class is designed for the officer with an intermediate or higher level of proficiency with the service pistol or revolver. It will increase the speed, accuracy, and confidence of the officer to win within the ranges where most handgun fights occur, seven yards.

**Topics covered:** The role of the handgun; selection of the handgun and ammunition; carrying on and off duty; drills from within arm's reach to seven yards; contact shooting; closing with and holding an opponent; proper presentation of the handgun; fighting stances; multiple opponents; unusual positions; targets at odd angles; responses left, right, and rear; one-handed shooting; shooting with flashlights, and shooting on the move. The course also includes the "Finish the Fight" program.

**REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:** A duty-quality pistol or revolver; service and off-duty leather gear; three magazines or speedloaders; flashlight with carrier; ear and eye protection; a minimum 1,000 rounds of handgun ammunition; and appropriate range clothing and gear.

**INSTRUCTOR:** Jeffrey Hall retired after 20 years with the Alaska State Troopers. Hall served 12 years on the statewide SWAT team, the Tactical Dive Unit, and on the state pistol team. He has over 3,000 hours of specialized tactics and firearms training. Hall has taught nationally and has published numerous articles on training and firearms. Hall is an adjunct staff instructor with the NRA, and is a master instructor in several states. Hall is an NRA Distinguished Master and is a Handgun Combat Master. Hall is also a martial artist with 3<sup>rd</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> dan rank in five arts.

THIS CLASS IS PHYSICALLY AND MENTALLY DEMANDING AND WILL EXCEED THE NORMAL EIGHT- HOUR WORK DAY. ALL STUDENTS MUST BE PHYSICALLY CAPABLE OF PARTICIPATING IN ALL DRILLS.
