<b>Equipment:</b>	<b>REQUIRED equipment for EACH student:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Duty handgun and Patrol duty belt with a minimum of 3 magazines. All applicants should consider bringing a duplicate spare duty pistol.</li><li>• Dummy training pistol to fit your duty holster (red or blue gun)</li><li>• Double-Action revolver, any caliber, w/ 2 speed-loaders &amp; belt holster</li><li>• Two duty flashlights, or one duty flashlight and one backup</li><li>• Eye protection (including clear glasses for night firing)</li><li>• Hearing protection – electronic headphones and earplugs</li><li>• Review and be ready to discuss your agency's firearms policies (we will be comparing agencies policy to current law).</li><li>• Weapon cleaning equipment</li><li>• Body armor</li><li>• Baseball hat</li><li>• Laptop</li><li>• USB flash drive</li></ul> <b>REQUIRED ammunition:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1000 rounds primary handgun</li><li>• 100 rounds revolver</li><li>• 100 rounds frangible</li><li>• A minimum of 20 dummy rounds for your duty pistol</li></ul>
