

About The Class

Can be used for a variety of criminal investigations to include but not limited to child pornography, child molestation, fraud cases, theft, homicide, or any crime involving the internet.

Students will be required to bring a laptop to the class. Personal or work issued is acceptable.

This class is designed for sex offender probation officers, detectives and investigators who want to preview computers on scene, knock and talks. This is designed to use the best practice in computer seizure and on-scene examinations. Investigators who want to conduct a knock and talk can use these tools and knowledge to further the investigation. This is a forensic sound method and is the current best practice. Probation officers and detectives can interview the suspect and conduct a quick preview of the computer by the use of the program. Students will receive a flash drive and the software during this course. Students who complete the class will be able to conduct previews of suspects computers with the use of the device.

This course is designed to provide students with the tools and knowledge to conduct computer seizures and be able to preview a suspects computer on-scene with the use of a variety of tools and software encountered in child sexual exploitation cases (child pornography). Students will be instructed on the best practice for computer seizure and will complete a hands-on seizure in class. In addition a variety of on-scene preview tools will be discussed. Students will also be provided a preview tool and thumb drive to complete investigations.

** A variety of preview tools will be discussed that can be bought from private vendors or downloaded for free. Details will be provided in class.

** Upon completion students will receive a thumb drive and program and a certification in computer seizure to include in the use of the tool.

About the Speaker

Sergeant Jerry Barker has been a law enforcement officer since July 1988 and is currently a sergeant with the Phoenix Police Department. He is currently the Arizona Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Commander. Sgt. Barker instructs at the Arizona Law Enforcement Academy, Northern Arizona Regional Training Academy and various other teaching assignments around the country. He worked crimes against children for 10 years as a detective before being promoted and specializes in physical / fatal child abuse, shaken baby syndrome, child sexual abuse and sexual exploitation of a minor (images and movies depicting the sexual abuse of children). Sgt. Barker has specialized training in child death investigations, child sexual abuse, crime scenes involving shaken baby, computer forensics, specialized suspect interview and interrogation of offenders who abuse children, and mental health for detectives that investigate crimes against children.
