Commercial Motor Vehicle Enforcement – Basic / Advanced

Location: **Enzian Inn, 590 Highway 2, Leavenworth, Washington 98826**

Course Date: June 2 thru 6, 2014

Course Time: Monday, 1200 – 1700; Tuesday thru Friday 0800 – 1700, 1-Hour lunch each day

Course Cost: **\$ 325.00 per Student (Includes Deluxe Catered Lunch – Monday thru Friday)**
All Class Materials are provided.

Course Instructors: This course is conducted by the Wacveo President DL Diess.

Course Information: This course is divided into seven major components;

- 1) **Commercial Driver & Vehicle Licensing:** The student will be able to distinguish between the different types of Commercial Drivers Licenses, their endorsements and restrictions and other required driver qualifications. The participant will be able to correlate these licenses with the different types of commercial vehicles.
- 2) **Required Equipment, Components and Load Securement:** The student will be able to determine the effectiveness of the vehicles equipment and determine whether or not the equipment is in compliance with federal and state regulations. The participant will receive in-depth instruction on a commercial vehicles components and required equipment. The student will acquire working knowledge of the lawful and proper methods of load securement for commercial vehicles.
- 3) **Size, Weight & Load:** The student will learn properly weigh a commercial motor vehicle using portable scales to determine its compliance with city, county and state weight regulations and road restrictions. The student will receive working knowledge of the requirements for transporting over-dimensional and over legal weight loads. The student will acquire an understanding of the permitting process.
- 4) **Inspection Procedures:** The student will learn to properly perform a Level II and III Commercial Vehicle Inspection. These inspections are commonly called a walk around inspection.
- 5) **Record of Duty Status:** The student will receive the latest information on federal and state Record of Duty Status. The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance continually revise the regulations regarding a driver's hours of service or record of duty status. Many major changes have been made that will drastically affect local and long haul commercial drivers.
- 6) **Hazardous Materials:** The participant will receive general regulatory training dealing with commercial motor vehicles transporting Hazardous Materials through populated areas, i.e. where they can and cannot be parked, filing routing plans and loading and unloading procedures.
- 7) **CVE Practical Exercise:** Once the class instruction has been completed, students working with other City & County CV Enforcement Officers will receive practical training while participating in an 8 hour CV enforcement exercise alongside the Chelan County Sheriff's Department. The student will be shown how to apply what they have learned in class.
