Use of Force Civil Liability:

The Use of Force Civil Liability portion of the seminar reviews the federal standards of 42 USC Section 1983 litigation against law enforcement officers, command staff and municipalities. This training reviews and discusses the legal standards applicable to Section 1983 actions to include Fourth Amendment violations. A portion of the training is specific to the use of force standards across the United States, as they apply to use of force continuums, the use of handcuffing, cap-stun, and the application of deadly force.

Electronic Control Weapon Liability:

The Electronic Control Weapon portion of the seminar reviews and focuses on the current issues addressing TASER® use; to include legal update, training, policy and procedures, evidence collection, medical response. The seminar reviews and focuses on recent TASER® use incidents across the country. In particular, the impact of TASER® use on current use of force standards.

Reporting Use of Force:

After a re-examination of the Constitutional standards and civil rights laws, the seminar focuses on managing confrontations, various interpretations of video-recorded incidents, and the drafting of use of force reports. Through lecture, video instruction and table-top exercises, attendees will learn the importance of drafting use of force reports under the proper constitutional and case law standards. Attendees will review videos of use of force incidents and prepare reports interpreting the events. Past reports will be examined for completeness and best practices.
