## LAW ENFORCEMENT RIFLE/CARBINE INSTRUCTOR TACTICAL FIREARM SKILL DEVELOPMENT

### **Course Description:**

This is an instructor level *Tactical Firearm Skill Development* course where the student will increase their own shooting skill for the purpose of transferring skill development to their students. The course will specifically focus on law enforcement's use of the rifle/carbine; however students will be presented with training concepts and methodology that remain consistent no matter the firearm used. This will include fundamental concepts that are simple, effective, and apply to the handgun, shotgun, and rifle/carbine.

Students will receive both instructional and live fire training to bring their rifle/carbine knowledge and shooting skill to an instructor proficiency level. Students will also be presented with the concepts and material to successfully transfer their shooting skills to their students.

Training consists of 5 days (50 hours) of instruction that will prepare students to:

- (a) Conduct department mandated shooting courses
- (b) Develop training curriculum specific to increasing rifle/carbine shooting skills
- (c) Diagnose shooting performance issues with their students
- (d) Implement training concepts which translate to effective use of deadly force

Those who successfully complete the course will receive a Certificate of Training, those who demonstrate they can effectively instruct others utilizing the methods taught will receive an Instructor Certificate.

- Duty handgun with magazines (3 mags min)
- Patrol rifle/carbine (3 mags min)
- Shotgun (patrol type capable of firing trap loads)
- Patrol duty belt and all related gear
- Spare rifle mag holder (belt or weapon mount)
- Iron sights for rifle (in addition to any optics)
- Handheld flashlight
- Shot Timer
- Spare patrol rifle recommended
- Copy of Dept. Use of Force Policy (to include Firearms Policies)
  - If your Department utilizes select fire weapons, please bring one if available. As an instructor you need a basic familiarization with all weapons that you will supervise on your range.
- 500 rounds handgun training ammo
- 2000 rounds rifle training ammo
- 50 rounds shotgun (lead trap loads)
- Patrol ballistic vest
- Gun cleaning kit
- Eye and Ear protection
- Weather/Range appropriate dress
- Bottled water/ sport drink (hydration)
- Knee Pads (Optional-Recommended)
- Copy of Dept. Qualification Course (Patrol Rifle)

**Note:** Listed round counts are to ensure student has plenty of training ammunition. Training is student based, and will not necessarily require total ammunition supply. Multiple students from same agency can bring one shotgun per every two students.

**No STEEL** jacket/core rifle or shot will be allowed. Student ammunition will be inspected.
