Most commonly asked defense attorney questions. *Texas v. Hall, Texas v. Sparks, Honeycutt v. Kentucky, Ferency v. Michigan, Aquilera v. Florida* reviewed. Proper set up procedures of radar and laser guns covered. Court cases of officer certification nationally and in Washington State. IACP means International Association of Chiefs of Police.
