

Dick Fairburn has more than 30 years of law enforcement experience in both Illinois and Wyoming, working patrol, investigations and administrative assignments. Dick has also served as a Criminal Intelligence Analyst and as the Section Chief of a major academy's Firearms Training Unit and Critical Incident training program. He has a B.S. in Law Enforcement Administration from Western Illinois University and was the Valedictorian of his recruit class at the Illinois State Police Academy. He has published more than 100 feature articles and two books: *Police Rifles* and *Building a Better Gunfighter*.

The threats faced by 21st Century U.S. law enforcement officers are severe and growing. For more than a decade the incidence of violent crime is dropping nationwide, but the violence of those crimes is growing exponentially. A special threat is the number of officers being murdered in an ambush. We face mass murder scenes where active shooters attack innocent citizens at their workplaces, schools and entertainment venues. Most agencies have trained Rapid Deployment/Active Shooter Response tactics, but have they trained their leaders to assemble and command those teams?

In the “Led by a Lion” seminar, noted PoliceOne.com columnist and trainer Richard Fairburn presents an outline for tactical police leadership during a critical incident. This is **NOT** a management seminar. Instead, we will discuss the leadership skills needed to take a small team of officers into a dangerous scene to effectively engage threats and ensure this dangerous mission is accomplished as safely as possible. Using a multi-media presentation including theatrical movie and historical incident examples, Fairburn breaks down the core leadership components into the “Four C’s:” Competence, Courage, Communications and Compassion.
