

# Intelligence and Crime Analysis (Crime Analyst – Level 1)

**This course is designed for the new or entry level crime analyst.**

**Description:** This course will provide the student with an overview of the day to day tasks and role of the crime and intelligence analyst in a law enforcement setting, and teach them the foundational skills of crime and intelligence analysis. The skillsets and knowledge taught in this course will enable the crime analyst to apply basic analytical techniques such as identifying crime patterns and trends and present the patterns and trends in both a written and presentation format. The content taught in this course will introduce the new crime analyst to various databases currently used by crime and intelligence analysts, new technologies utilized by the crime and intelligence fields, such as cell tower and phone tracking plotting and linking; social networking sites and the many uses of data mining social networking sites.
