



Idaho Sheriffs' Association Detention In-Service Training Year One

This course is open to all employees who work in the field of Detention. The course was designed to help employees improve their knowledge and skills in their detention career as well as provide training on best practices in detention facilities. Each year for four years, the program will provide training in different modules so students are encouraged to attend all four years. After four years, the program will start over with updates and best practices to each of the year's modules so the students will continue to experience updated information. Twenty hours of training each year will allow students to maintain their detention certifications while receiving quality training.

This three day course consists of several modules created with today's progressive detention officer in mind. Subjects include Prison Rape Elimination Act, Legal Issues, Suicide Prevention, Sexual Misconduct, Use of Force, and Report Writing. Class is comprised of lecture and practical exercises.

The class is being held on two separate dates to provide more flexibility for scheduling within agencies and to allow more students from each agency to attend.
