



## TRAINING OPPORTUNITY - VISUAL TRACKING TRAINING OFFERED AT BELLEVUE COLLEGE

This fall, beginning September 25th, 2015, a new course will be offered at Bellevue College titled **Human Tracking**. This class quarter will consist of 77 hours, with an emphasis on “hands on” training in outdoor and indoor environments. Classes will be offered over several weekends, starting on Friday and ending on Sunday.

### Total: 77 hours for 5 credits

Students will learn how to identify, interpret and document physical evidence directly related to human movement and travel. The students will learn how this evidence is relevant to the processing of a crime scene.

Students with accumulated tracking training hours from the Joel Hardin Tracking program, will assist tracking teams in the field and will learn advanced tracking techniques. These techniques will include problem solving, ageing older tracks and the fundamentals of being a tracking team leader.

Students will be trained by Professional Visual Trackers who are active in their field of Search and Rescue and Law Enforcement. This training will follow the Basic certification course outline offered by Joel Hardin Professional Tracking Services. <http://jhardin-inc.com/web/>

The cost for this training will be \$534.20 with a college application fee of \$33.00.
