Officer Zucker has extensive experience working with the Southern Nevada Counter Terrorism Center, and the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. Since 2009, Officer Zucker has taught courses to law enforcement and corrections throughout the U.S. Currently assigned to the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Detention Special Investigations Unit, Officer Zucker's daily responsibilities includes interviewing Mexican drug traffickers arrested to obtain information and possible intelligence that will assist law enforcement in prosecuting suspects in the future. Officer Zucker has discovered that like gang members, drug traffickers get arrested and while incarcerated, link up with other drug trafficking criminals for future crimes. Officer Zucker spends hours a day researching current information, Mexican current events and social media sites related to Mexican Drug Cartels.
