Participants are requested to report, in athletic type clothing ready to take the SWAT PAT, on **Sunday, April 10, 2011**, to the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission, 19010 1st Ave. S., Burien, WA 98148 at **11:00 AM**

Lodging, Travel, and Meals: Travel and meals will be the responsibility of the participant or his or her agency. **There will be no reimbursement for expenses.**

Prerequisites: Must be a current member of SWAT team, proficient with intermediate rifle or (SMG) and handgun. Must also meet WASPC Physical Fitness standards to gain entry to the course: 35 push-ups, 35 sit-ups, 6 pull-ups, and complete 1.5 mile run in 12:30 or less. Costs: **\$600.** No-shows **OR** students failing Physical Fitness Test **will be charged the full course fee.**

Agencies will be billed after the class is completed.

Cancellation Guidelines: In order to avoid being charged the full course fee, applications must be **canceled** via email blearegistrar@cjtc.state.wa.us no later than **April 4, 2011**. **No exceptions will be made.**

Attendance: 100% attendance is required. The student will be required to pass a written test with a minimum score of 80%. Certificates of completion will be awarded to those students who successfully complete the course.

Equipment
Needs:**

Required equipment: Please bring the following items with you to class.

- Tactical uniform
- Ballistic vest
- Load-bearing vest
- Physical training attire (Day one physical testing)
- Gas mask and carrier (properly fitted and function tested)
- Helmet
- Muffs or plugs for hearing protection
- Shatter-resistant glasses for eye protection
- Flashlight
- Mirrors
- One intermediate rifle or sub-machine gun, one handgun, and at least three magazines for each
- Ammunition: handgun-350 rounds; intermediate rifle/sub gun-350 rounds
- Students should bring any other agency equipment that would be used on a SWAT call. **No NFDD's or chemical munitions please.**

Optional equipment: Portable radios, knee pads, elbow pads.
