IT IS DESIGNED TO ASSIST IN PROVIDING A SOLID FOUNDATION OF BASIC TECHNIQUES FROM WHICH DETECTIVES CAN BUILD UPON AS THEY PROGRESS THROUGH THEIR CAREERS. POLICIES AND PROCEDURES DIFFER FROM AGENCY TO AGENCY AND THIS PRESENTATION IS A GENERAL OVERVIEW, NOT TO CONFLICT WITH YOUR DEPARTMENT OPERATING GUIDELINES IN CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS.
