DESCRIPTION:

This course will provide a full discussion of the Public Records Act and its application to Law Enforcement Agencies. We will provide a statutory overview of the requirements for your records disclosure program and the need to adopt proactive public records policies. We will discuss statutory provisions concerning records organization, how to respond to records requests and ensure timely production of records. We will discuss recent cases adding requirements for reasonable searches of records, and explanation of exemptions. The course will examine specific exemptions for law enforcement records, including investigative records and intelligence information, personnel records and internal affairs investigations. We will address how the PRA affects use of police dashcams and body cameras. We will cover the Criminal Records Privacy Act, as well as other Washington statutes addressing law enforcement records and juvenile records, including recent amendments on sealing juvenile records. The course will also provide an update on recent developments in the courts and legislation affecting public records law. This course is presented by Jeffrey S. Myers of Law, Lyman, Daniel, Kamerrer, and Bogdanovich.
