Participants are requested to report on **Sunday, July 17, 2011 at 9:00 AM**, to the **Port of Seattle Training Building, 19639 #F 28th Avenue South, SeaTac, WA 98188** for the first day.

**Lodging, Travel, and Meals:** Travel and meals will be the responsibility of the participant or his or her agency. **There will be no reimbursement for expenses.**

**Costs:** Agencies will be billed \$500 after the course is completed.

**Cancellation Guidelines:** In order to avoid being charged the full course fee, applications must be canceled via email [blearegistrar@cjtc.state.wa.us](mailto:blearegistrar@cjtc.state.wa.us) no later than **July 11, 2011**. **No exceptions will be made.**

**Attire:** Arrive in appropriate training/uniform/SWAT attire.

**Equipment Needs: Required Equipment:**

- Handgun. (This course does not involve live-fire exercises)
- Intermediate rifle or sub-machine gun. (This course does not involve live-fire exercises)
- Simunition® Conversion Kit for assigned handgun and rifle/SMG OR dedicated Simunition® handgun and rifle/SMG.
- Ammunition:
  - 300 Rounds 9mm Simunition® FX Marking Cartridges. **ONLY 9mm FX Marking Cartridges - No 5.56mm / .223 RIFLE Marking Cartridges allowed.**
- Suitable Personal Protective Equipment, (helmet, face, throat & groin) which provides necessary protection during Dynamic Scenarios involving the use of Simunition® 9mm FX ® Marking Cartridges.
- Students should bring their tactical gear normally carried during mission deployment. **EXCEPT: No NFDD's or Chemical Munitions please.**
