Training Announcement: ***POLICE MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAINING***

WHEN: September 18, 2015 to September 21, 2015, 8 am to 4 pm

WHERE: Milton Police Department, 1000 Laurel Street, Milton, WA

The Milton Police Department is hosting a 32 hour Police Mountain Bike Training on September 18, 2015 to September 21, 2015, 8 am to 4 pm daily at the Milton Police Department. Mr. Bill Mack, a certified International Police Mountain Bike Association (IPMBA) instructor with Pierce County Transit will be the lead instructor.

The participating agencies will share the instruction costs. Current cost per student is \$200. As the class size increases, the cost per student will decrease. The City of Milton will invoice each agency after the completion of the course. Each student is required to provide the following equipment:

- Mountain Bike
- Eyewear
- Gloves
- Camelback hydration pack
- Bike uniform with vest
- IPMBA membership dues
- Helmet
- Bike shoes with toe clips
- Duty gear

Prior to starting class, please practice riding your bike to be fit to ride prior to the start of the course. The class could be physically challenging if not prepared.
